Kia ora,

Today we are bringing you a News Bulletin that notifies you about the new Outage Disclosure website that industry participants will need to use as of **1 April 2023**.

The Gas (Facilities Outage Information Disclosure) Rules 2022 come into effect on 1 April 2023.

The purpose of these rules is to provide for effective and timely disclosure of information regarding an unplanned outage or planned outage at a gas production facility or a gas storage facility for all gas and related market participants.

These rules provide for -

- The disclosure of information regarding an unplanned outage or planned outage at a gas production facility or a gas storage facility; and
- The disclosure of information to the industry body to enable it to monitor compliance with these rules.

We have developed a new website to enable gas producers and gas storage owners to make disclosures under the Rules and for stakeholders to review information that is disclosed.

From 1 April 2023, you will need to access this <u>website</u> to view planned and unplanned outages of gas production and storage facilities.

If you currently receive email notification of outages from Gas Industry Co's Industry Notifications website, you will automatically start receiving notifications from the new website. If you don't already receive email notifications, you can sign up to receive notifications on the new website.

The current Industry Notifications page will not be accessible from 1 April 2023.

Over the next few days, the website developers may post a few test notifications to test aspects of the functionality as the system beds in. These notifications will clearly be labelled as test notifications and will be removed once the testing is complete.
