In December 2019, we issued our Consultation Paper: Consultation on Gas Industry Co FY2021 Work Programme and Levy. The Consultation Paper is in respect of our proposed work programme and levy for FY2021. This is a further reminder that submissions are due by **5.00pm, Monday 10 February 2020**.

January 2020 switching numbers available

The Gas Registry statistics recording gas consumer switching numbers for January 2020 are available [here](#). There were 3216 completed customer switches during the month, 507 fewer than December 2019, and 1 fewer than January 2019.

For the last couple of years switching numbers and the time they take to complete has been relatively stable. In the last 12 months we saw, on average, 3,707 switches taking place per month, and they took an average of two days to complete. During that time the highest number of switches occurred in July 2019 (4,408) and the lowest occurred in January 2020 (3,216).
