QUESTION		COMMENT
Q1:	Do submitters have any comments on the rule 42 exemption application DR08-25-S from Vector?	does not support exemption beyond the end of November; and does not support special treatment of time limit breaches. If the proposed 'legacy' changes to the Maui Pipeline Operating Code (MPOC) go through, then shippers will face a new balancing environment from early December. From that time, retailers will benefit from daily access to the injection data under rule 42. Genesis Energy agrees that the compliance regime is the best way to settle whether breaches are material or not.
Q2:	Do submitters have any comments on the rule 41 exemption for nominated direct connect gas gates application DR08-26-T from Vector?	Genesis Energy supports this exemption. The information is already available via OATIS, so the rule would simply add costs.
Q3:	Do submitters have any comments on the application DR08-27-U from Nova seeking exemption from the allocation of gas for "bypass pipeline" gas gates?	Genesis Energy does not support this exemption. Nova Gas benefits from market arrangements and should participate on an equal basis with other retailers and distributors. This application does not differ significantly from Nova's earlier exemption application.
