If a deadline of 1200 hours on the third business day of the second month following the consumption period was in place, the allocation agent would have concerns around the accuracy of initial allocations in the situation where a retailer has <u>commenced</u> supplying at a gas gate. The allocation agent supports a deadline of no later than 1200 hours on the third business day of the month following the consumption period in which the retailer commenced/ceased to supply gas at a gas gate.
