Shell welcomes the GIC's Draft Recommendation on the MPOC Change Request submitted by MDL on 10 October 2014, the MBBCR.

We agree with many of the findings and are fully supportive of the final conclusion of the Draft Recommendation.

We note that the Cost Benefit Analysis (CBA) did not attempt to quantify a number of the benefits of the MBBCR. These are:

- Improved market liquidity
- Dynamic efficiency gains (such as reduced cost of swing)
- Upstream benefits as a result of lower and more stable pipeline pressure

We support the decision not to invest further time and money quantifying the above benefits for a business case that is already clear. But we note that if the conclusion, based on the existing scope of analysis, was to change for any reason, we would expect the above benefits to be more clearly factored in to a revised CBA.
