Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	Gas (Switching Arrangements) Rules 2008: r51.2 If the distributor receives a request under Rule 51.1, the distributor must, within 3 business days of receiving that request, assign an ICP to the new consumer installation or notify the retailer of the reason why it is unable to assign an ICP. r51.3. Once a distributor receives confirmation that a new consumer installation is first connected to its distribution system, the distributor must, within 2 business days of receiving that confirmation, enter in the registry the following information from Part A of Schedule 1 – r51.3.1 The ICP identifier; and r51.3.2 The ICP creation date; and r51.3.3 The responsible distributor code; and r51.3.4 The physical address of the consumer installation.
Material Issue	No material issue/s is raised. The Market Administrator has, in determining the materiality of the alleged breach, taken into account the factors listed in regulation 19(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008 to the extent the factors are practical or relevant. The Market Administrator has also taken into account any information provided in accordance with regulation 14(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008.²
