




## 3. Allocation Results

### 3.2. Injection/Consumption<sup>2</sup>


All gas gates with an injection / consumption ratio over 1.1 or less than 0.9 (1d.p)



Change in allocated gas by retailer for the **OCTOBER 2021** allocation period


