# Updating the Guidelines for Determining Regional Critical Contingencies – Consultation now open

Gas Industry Co has released a consultation paper to invite feedback on draft updates to the Guidelines for Determining Regional Critical Contingencies.

The Gas Governance (Critical Contingency Management) Regulations 2008 require Gas Industry Co to prepare and publish guidelines to assist the Critical Contingency Operator (CCO) in determining whether a critical contingency event is regional. This distinction is relevant, because the imbalance arrangements do not apply in the case of a regional critical contingency, and should not be operative in circumstances where they are not needed.

The proposed changes have been designed to improve readability, to update the network configuration schematics, and to add a sixth critical contingency scenario.

## Reminder: Outage Information Disclosure Rules: Annual Monitoring Disclosures and Certificates due by 15 April

Gas producers and gas storage owners are required to provide Gas Industry Co with their annual Part 5 information disclosures, and certificate of correctness, by 15 April 2025.

The Gas (Facilities Outage Information Disclosure) Rules 2022 provide for effective and timely disclosure of information regarding a planned or unplanned outage at a gas production facility or a gas storage facility, for all gas and related market participants.

## Consultation on correcting submission errors at TUK06502

In March 2025 we completed a consultation which proposed financial settlement to address a submission error at the Tuakau gas gate (TUK06502).

This related to an error which occurred in November 2021, when Genesis Energy underreported 4,352 gigajoules (GJ) of gas. The the paper proposed a financial settlement.

Submissions on the consultation paper closed at 5:00pm on Friday, March 28, 2025.

No formal submissions were received during the consultation period. However, informal feedback from the two largest participants at the Tuakau gas gate supported moving forward with the settlement. As a result, Gas Industry Co will now proceed to facilitate the settlement.
