## Supply and Demand study

Gas Industry Co will release the latest Supply and Demand study in February.

The annual study is designed to improve understanding about the role of gas now and into the future, and to provide stakeholders with useful information to make informed decisions.

Previous Supply and Demand studies were released at the end of the year, just before the Christmas/New Year break. To ensure the next study receives the focus it deserves and to better align with other work at Gas Industry Co, we have rescheduled the release date to early February.

Our Notice of Determinations by the Industry Body under the Gas (Downstream Reconciliation) Rules 2008, includes a determination that Wellington Anniversary is treated as a non-business day as long as the Allocation Agent is based in Wellington.

This is in addition to the nationally observed public holidays that are also non-business days under the Reconciliation Rules.
