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Recommendation to amend CCM Regulations

On 2 July we sent our Recommendation to the Minister for Energy for changes to the Gas Governance (Critical Contingency Management) Regulations 2008.

The changes are intended to make the critical contingency management regime more efficient and effective without compromising long-term security of supply.

Most of the changes relate to process improvements identified during previous contingency events and exercises. They also include amendments to update wording, remove ambiguity, and improve communication and information quality for parties involved in managing a critical contingency event.

Finally, the changes also recommend retaining the urgent amendments to the CCM Regulations that removed the Broadlands and Taupo gas gates from the critical contingency threshold limits that came into effect on 8 March 2024.

The next step is for the Minister to consider our recommendation and decide whether to accept or reject it.
