In particular, the focus on the challenges the gas sector faces as a consequence of New Zealand's transition to a net zero economy by 2050. While there is considerable uncertainty regarding the pace of this transition, GIC has a key role in ensuring it is as orderly as possible, and affordability and energy security is maintained.   |

It is important that development of the plan is not delayed, to provide certainty to the industry and ensure that the broader National Energy Strategy is also delivered on time. Genesis considers that development of the Gas Transition Plan is a high priority activity, and therefore it would be reasonable to consider reprioritising some workstreams to ensure the plan is delivered on schedule, if this becomes necessary. |
