The alleged breach will therefore be referred to investigation in accordance with regulation 18(3).</p> <p>The market administrator placed particular weight on the following criteria in making its determination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • regulation 19(1)(b) – the alleged breach may have had a material impact on the operation of the market • regulation 19(1)(c) – the alleged breach was based on AGCL's understanding of the requirements of the rules at the time • regulation 19(1)(f) – the alleged breach may have resulted in cost and frustration to the consumer and EGLT • regulation 19(1)(i) – it appears likely that similar breaches may occur in the future • regulation 19(1)(o) - the Rulings Panel has recently interpreted the requirements of rule 72.2.1 • regulation 19(1)(o) – the event in question is related to a switch
