Determination made by market administrator under regulation 18:	<p>In the market administrator's opinion, the alleged breaches do not raise material issues and the market administrator has decided to take no action on the alleged breaches.</p> <p>The market administrator placed particular weight on the following criteria in making its determination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • regulation 19(1)(b) – the alleged breaches are unlikely to have had a material impact on the market • regulation 19(1)(c) – some alleged breaches were not inadvertent • regulation 19(1)(g) – the alleged breaches are admitted • regulation 19(1)(h) – GNVG has advised that it has changed its approach • regulation 19(1)(o) – the 'compliance environment' was taken into account, as the approach taken was considered by GNVG to be consistent with responses GNVG had provided to the market administrator in response to allegations made by EGAS and EGLT
