Provision of consumption information for initial allocation</p> <p>To enable the allocation agent to perform an initial allocation for each consumption period at each allocated gas gate, every retailer must provide, in respect of the consumer installations at an allocated gas gate for which it is the responsible retailer, the following consumption information to the allocation agent by 1200 hours on the 4th business day of the month that immediately follows the consumption period to which the information relates:</p> <p>r31.1 Daily metered energy quantities for each consumer installation in allocation groups 1 and 2</p>
Material Issue	<p>No material issue/s is raised.</p> <p>The Market Administrator has, in determining the materiality of the alleged breach, taken into account the factors listed in regulation 19(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008 to the extent the factors are practical or relevant.</p> <p>The Market Administrator has also taken into account any information provided in accordance with regulation 14(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008.²</p>
