Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	Gas (Switching Arrangements) Rules 2008 Rule 70.2 A gas acceptance notice must state an expected switch date which, except as required under rule 72.2, is not limited to any requested switch date in the gas switching notice; but must be no later than 10 business days after the date the responsible retailer received the gas switching notice from the registry. Rule 72.2 Subject to rules 72.3 and 72.4, if the gas switching notice included a requested switch date that complied with rule 67.3 or 67.3A, the responsible retailer must use the requested switch date as the switch date and provide switch readings applicable to that date.
Material Issue	No material issue/s is raised. The Market Administrator has, in determining the materiality of the alleged breach/es, taken into account the factors listed in regulation 19(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008 to the extent the factors are practical or relevant.
