RE: GTAC Workshop Plan – Revised Following Block 3

We would like to thank participants for their valuable input during the workshops over the last two months. These workshops have covered the substantive points on the GTAC and the Receipt Point and Delivery Point Interconnection Agreements identified in the Final Assessment Paper (FAP).

This memo sets out the workshop plan for the remaining work up until the issue of the GTAC to stakeholders for consultation in mid-September 2018. The remaining work to be completed relates to supporting arrangements for the GTAC and a full review of the GTAC drafting.

Timeline Overview

An overview of the proposed timeline of meetings and submissions is provided in the table below. We consider this timeline provides an appropriate period for parties to ensure a good understanding of the changes made from the December 2017 GTAC and for the GIC to complete its assessment process. We also consider that this timeframe will enable a 1 October 2019 go live (if the GTAC is approved). This timeline will be reconsidered from time to time during the work programme to confirm that it remains fit for purpose in making progress towards ensuring that the GTAC is materially better than the existing codes.
