Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	 Gas (Downstream Reconciliation) Rules 2008 Rule 29.4.3 All consumer installations with non-TOU meters to which the retailer has continuously supplied gas for the previous 12-month period must have register readings recorded at least once every 12-months unless exceptional circumstances prevent such as interrogation.
Material Issue	No material issue/s is raised. The Market Administrator has, in determining the materiality of the alleged breach/es, taken into account the factors listed in regulation 19(1) of the Gas Governance (Compliance) Regulations 2008 to the extent the factors are practical or relevant.
