Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	<p>Gas (Downstream Reconciliation) Rules 2008</p> <p>Rule 39 Retailer to give gas gate trading notice to allocation agent</p> <p>Rule 39.1 A retailer must give notice to the allocation agent when the retailer –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rule 39.1.1 Commences to supply gas to a consumer installation at an allocated gas gate under a supplementary agreement to a transmission services agreement at which it has not previously supplied gas; or • Rule 39.1.2 Ceases to supply gas under a supplementary agreement to a transmission services agreement to any consumer installations at an allocated gas gate; or • Rule 39.1.3 Amends any of the information required to be provided under rule for a supplementary agreement to a transmission services agreement in respect of gas supplied at an allocated gas gate.
