Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	<p>Gas (Switching Arrangements) Rules 2008</p> <p>Rule 56 Meter owner information for new ICP</p> <p>Rule 56.1 Subject to Rule 56.3 and within the timeframe specified in Rule 56.2, the responsible meter owner for an ICP must enter in the registry values for all of the ICP parameters listed in Part C of Schedule 1.</p> <p>Rule 56.2 The timeframe is within 2 business days after the responsible meter owner –</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">56.2.1 Has confirmed that the metering equipment has been installed at the new consumer installation; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">56.2.2 Where Rule 56.3 does not apply, has been notified of the information under Rule 55.2 in relation to the ICP.</p> <p>Rule 56.3 If an ICP has an ICP status of NEW or READY and no responsible meter owner exists for that ICP, a meter owner who has installed metering equipment at the new consumer installation –</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">56.3.1 May enter in the registry values for all of the ICP parameters listed in Part C of Schedule 1; and</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">56.3.2 In doing so, is deemed to become the responsible meter owner.</p>
