Rule/Regulation allegedly breached	Rule 27.1.2 Gas (Downstream Reconciliation) Rules 2008  27.1 For the purposes of gas volume information required to be collected or provided under these rules:  27.1.1 Every meter owner must ensure that all metering equipment used to collect that volume information complies with NZS 5259;  27.1.2 Metering equipment which has a margin of error of less than the relevant margins of error specified in NZS 5259 is considered to be accurate; and  27.1.3 Any verification of accuracy must be in accordance with NZS 5259.
Material Issue	No material issue/s is raised.
