<b>Determination made by market administrator under regulation 18:</b>	<p>In the market administrator's opinion the alleged breach does raise a material issue. The alleged breach will therefore be referred to investigation in accordance with regulation 18(3).</p> <p>The market administrator placed particular weight on the following criteria in making its determination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• regulation 19(1)(f) – the alleged breach has potentially resulted in costs being borne by other participants or persons</li> <li>• regulation 19(1)(g) – the alleged breach is not admitted</li> <li>• regulation 19(1)(n) – the complexity of the facts warrant investigation.</li> </ul> <p>The market administrator notes that this alleged breach arises from the same circumstances as Breach Notices 2009-22, 23 and 24.</p>
