<b>Determination made by market administrator under regulation 18:</b>	<p>In the market administrator's opinion, the alleged breaches do raise a material issue. The alleged breaches will therefore be referred to investigation in accordance with regulation 18(3).</p> <p>The market administrator placed particular weight on the following criteria in making its determination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• regulation 19(1)(l) – there appears some likelihood that same alleged breach may occur in future</li> <li>• regulation 19(1)(h) – the alleged breach may indicate a potential systemic problem with compliance with rule 72</li> <li>• regulation 19(1)(n) – the complexity of the facts warrant investigation.</li> </ul> <p>The market administrator notes that the issues raised in these alleged breaches were also raised in breach notice 2009-23, which is currently under investigation.</p>
